# **Class Objective**

I will learn to converse in Kannada while shopping for fruits.

Shopping or buying is called 'Kharidisuvudu' in Kannada.



### Concept A: Fruits in Kannada

English	Kannada
Apple	Sebu(ಸ <u>ໍ</u> ໝ)
Orange	Kittale(ಕಿತ್ತಲೆ)
Papaya	Parangi(ಪರಂಗಿ)
Pomegranate	Dalimbe(ದಾಳಿಂಬೆ)
Mango	Mavina Hannu(ಮಾವು / ಮಾವಿನಾ ಹನ್ನು)
Grapes	Drakshi (ದ್ರಾಕ್ಷಿಗಳು)
Jack fruit	Halasina hannu(ಹಲಾಸಿನಾ ಹನ್ನು)
Banana	Balehannu(ಬಾಳೆಹಣ್ಣ)
Chikku	Sapota(ಸಪೋಟಾ)



#### Concept B: Common questions asked during shopping for fruits

Do you have fresh apples?

Nimma bali/hattira thaja sebugalu ideye?

(ನೀವು ತಾಜಾ ಸೇಬುಗಳನ್ನು ಹೊಂದಿದ್ದೀರಾ?)

How much are Mangoes per kg?

Ondu kg mavina hannina bele eshtu?

(ಒಂಡು ಕೆಜಿ ಮಾವಿನಾ ಹನ್ನಿನಾ ಬೇಲೆ ಎಸ್ತು?)



#### Concept B: Common questions asked during shopping for fruits

What is the cost of 1 papaya?

Ondu parangihannu eshtu?

(ಒಂಡು ಪರಂಗಿಹನ್ನು ಎಸ್ತು?)

How much is a dozen bananas cost?

Ondu dozen balahannu eshtu?

(ಒಂದು ಡಜನ್ ಬಾಳಹಣ್ಣಿನ ಬೆಲೆ ಎಷ್ಟು?)



#### Concept B: Common questions asked during shopping for fruits

How many oranges will come for 1 kg?

1 kg yalli 6 kittalegalu iruttade?

(1 ಕೆಜಿಗೆ ಎಷ್ಟು ಕಿತ್ತಳೆ ಬರುತ್ತದೆ?)

Can I return these grapes?.

Nanu drakshigalannu vapas/hinthirigisu kodabahude?

(ನಾನು ಈ ದ್ರಾಕ್ಷಿಯನ್ನು ವಾಪಸ್ / ಹಿಂದಿರುಗಿಸಬಹುದೇ?)
