### Conjugation:

#### 1. - ER ending verbs:

We remove the infinitive ending and add the respective suffixes.

Parler : parl

	suffixes	conjugation
Je	-ai	parlai
Tu	-as	parlas

Nous	-âmes	parlâmes
Vous	-âtes	parlâtes
Ils /Elles	-èrent	parlèrent

### 2. - IR and -RE ending verbs:

We remove the infinitive ending and add the respective suffixes.

Finir - fin

	suffixes	conjugation
Je	-is	finis
Tu	-is	finis
Il/Elle /On	-it	finit
