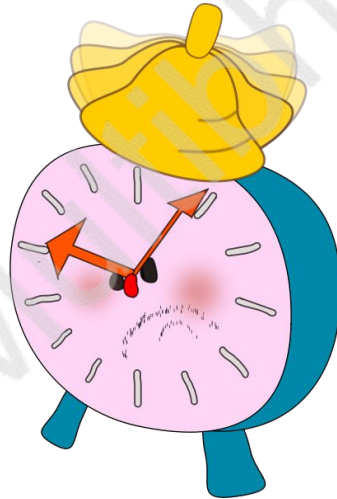

Concept A: Formal Greetings

- **Guten Tag** ⇒ Good day/ Good afternoon
- **Guten Abend** ⇒ Good evening
- **Gute Nacht** ⇒ Good night
- **Hallo** ⇒ Hello

• **Wie geht es Ihnen?** - How are you (Formal) : Ihnen is the appropriate formal address for a stranger, especially someone older, and people in positions of authority.

- **Entschuldigen Sie Bitte:** Excuse me Please
- **Willkommen:** Welcome

❖ Saying goodbye in formal way :



- **Auf Wiedersehen (OWF vee-der-zey-hen)** : You have probably heard “Auf Wiedersehen” before. It literally means “until we see each other again”.
