Concept A: VALORAR SITUACIONES Y HECHOS

(No) Es (No) Me parece	(i)lógico necesario suficiente (in)justo grave increíble normal importante estupendo terrible un horror una vergüenza una tontería ...	que + presente de subjuntivo infinitivo
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(No) Está (No) Me parece	(muy) bien / mal	que + presente de subjuntivo infinitivo
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Es	verdad cierto evidente	que + presente de indicativo
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• **A mí no me parece normal que consumamos** productos que vienen de la otra punta del mundo cuando los producimos también aquí...

° A ver, **es verdad que es** extraño, pero **no me parece tan grave que lo hagamos** así... Es la ley de la oferta y la demanda...

Está muy bien que en algunas ciudades prohíban usar el coche todos los días.

Note:

*Usamos el infinitivo cuando el hablante habla de sí mismo o queremos generalizar.

Creo que **es muy importante hacer** todo lo posible por contaminar menos.

Concept B: LO DE, LO QUE

Cuando queremos hablar de un tema familiar para los interlocutores o que ha sido mencionado antes, usamos **lo de** y **lo que**.

• Está muy bien **lo de compartir** coche: te ahorras gastos, conoces a gente nueva...
