

Present perfect (Regular verbs)
(Pretérito perfecto)

Class objective: To be able to understand the concept pretérito perfecto in Spanish.

Concept A: Pretérito perfecto de indicativo.

He tenido, me he levantado, he dado y he hecho son formas del pretérito perfecto de indicativo. (present Perfect indicative)

- Formación del pretérito perfecto de indicativo.

Presente de indicativo de haber +	participio del	verbo correspondiente
(yo)	he	
(tú)	has	trabajado
(usted) (él, ella)	ha	comido
(nosotros,-as)	hemos	vivido
(vosotros,-as)	habéis	
(ustedes) (ellos, ellas)	han	

AR = +ado = bailado (bailar)

ER & IR

= +ido = comido (comer) vivido(vivir)

Example:

- Yo he comido una pizza.
(I have eaten a pizza.)
- Yo me he bañado esta mañana.
(I have taken bath this morning.)

ATENCIÓN:

-- La forma del participio no cambia nunca. [The form of the participle never changes.]

- Hoy **he** comido paella. [Today I had paella.]
- Pues nosotras **hemos** comido pescado.[Well, we have eaten fish.]

-- Haber y el participio van siempre juntos.

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
