Class Objective: Learn how to introduce yourself in Russian.

CONCEPT A: How to ask someone's name in Russian.

- Как вас зовут?
- Kak-vas-zavoot?
- What is your name?(lit. How do they call you?)

The above-mentioned form is used before an elder or unfamiliar person.

- Как тебя зовут?
- Kak-chebya-zavoot?
- What is your name ?(lit. How do they call you?)

The above mentioned form is used before a younger person.

- Как его/её зовут?
- Kak evo/eyo zavoot?
- What is his/her name?

Note:

- Ero is used for third person masculine gender.
- Eë is used for third person feminine gender.

CONCEPT B: How to tell one's name.

Как вас зовут?

- Здравствуйте!(Formal greeting or salutation)
- Меня зовут Сергей.
- Menya-zavoot-sergei.
- My name is Sergei.(lit. I'm called Sergei)

CONCEPT C: How to formally greet when someone introduces oneself.

- Рад познакомиться!
- Rad-paznakomitsya!
- I'm glad to meet you!

The above mentioned phrase is used by masculine gender.

- Рада познакомиться!
- Rada-paznakomitsya!
- I'm glad to meet you
