## Concept A: Understanding Indefinite Pronouns

- An **indefinite pronoun** is one of a small group of pronouns such as
- everything, nobody, and something which are used to refer to people
- or things in a general way without saying exactly who or what they
- are.
- Some of the indefinite pronouns in German grammar are **etwas,**
- **nichts, man, jemand, jeder, niemand** etc.



## Concept A : Interrogative Pronoun wer, wen , wem , wessen and was

Beispiel :

Kannst du etwas für mich tun?

(Can you do something for me ?)

Jemand hat es genommen.

Somebody has stolen it.)



## Concept B : Indefinite Pronoun describing people

- Some general indefinite pronouns describing people are
- man, jemand, niemand, irgendjemand etc. The pronoun man is the
- equivalent of the English generic pronoun one or impersonal you.
- And, “jemand” and “niemand” also appear only in the third person
- singular. Whereas “jemand” refers to one unspecified
- person (someone/ someone), “niemand” is its negative (nobody / no
- one).

Dative	einem	jemandem	niemandem
