

Errors of history, overcome boundaries

Class Objective: I will be able to understand the facts and history related to holocaust.

Concept A: Einführung

Der Holocaust war die systematische, staatlich geförderte Verfolgung und Ermordung von sechs Millionen Juden durch das Nazi-Regime und seine Verbündeten und Kollaborateure. Holocaust ist ein Wort griechischen Ursprungs und bedeutet "Opfer durch Feuer". Die Nazis, die im Januar 1933 in Deutschland an die Macht kamen, glaubten, die Deutschen seien "rassisch überlegen" und die als "minderwertig" geltenden Juden seien eine fremde Bedrohung für die sogenannte deutsche Rassengemeinschaft.

Während der NS-Zeit zielten die deutschen Behörden wegen ihrer wahrgenommenen rassistischen und biologischen Unterlegenheit auch auf andere Gruppen: Roma (Zigeuner), Menschen mit Behinderungen, einige der slawischen Völker (Polen, Russen und andere), sowjetische Kriegsgefangene und Schwarze Leute. Andere Gruppen wurden aus politischen, ideologischen und verhaltensbezogenen Gründen verfolgt, darunter Kommunisten, Sozialisten, Zeugen Jehovas und Homosexuelle.

Concept B: Was war der Holocaust?

1933 betrug die jüdische Bevölkerung Europas über neun Millionen. Die meisten europäischen Juden lebten in Ländern, die Nazi-Deutschland während des Zweiten Weltkriegs besetzen oder beeinflussen würde. Bis Kriegsende 1945 töteten die Deutschen und ihre Verbündeten und Kollaborateure im Rahmen der „Endlösung“ fast zwei von drei europäischen Juden.
