Concept A: Verwendung von "Konjunktiv I"

Indirekte Rede

Konjunktiv I wird hauptsächlich für die indirekte Rede verwendet. Indirekte Rede ist, wenn der Erzähler das mitteilt, was von einer anderen Person gesagt wurde.

An ein paar Beispielen können Sie dies deutlicher sehen:

Hans: Ich bin 30 Jahre alt

Hans: "I am 30 years old" (Direct speech)

Hans sagte, sei 30 Jahre alt

Sein Säger ist 30 Jahre alt (Indirekte Rede)

Hans: Ich habe Durst

Hans: "Ich habe Durst" (Direkte Rede)

Hans sagt, dass er Durst habe

Hans says that he's thirsty (Indirect speech)

Sie sehen, dass der Satz mit Konjunktiv I ("er habe Durst") von einem Hauptsatz im Indikativ ("Hans sagt") begleitet wird.
