

1. Imperfecto de Subjuntivo

Objetivo de clase : Ya has estudiado el imperfecto de subjuntivo, ahora vamos a revisarlo.

Concepto A : ¿Qué es el imperfecto de subjuntivo?

El subjuntivo imperfecto (el pretérito imperfecto de subjuntivo) puede referirse al pasado, presente o futuro según el contexto.

Ejemplos :

- Ojalá trabajara desde casa.
- Me gustaría tener un trabajo que me permitiera vivir en cualquier sitio.
- No creo que viviera en una ciudad si pudiera teletrabajar.
- Y dudo que me cansara alguna vez del campo.
- ¡Quién tuviera una casita en medio de la montaña!

El subjuntivo imperfecto puede referirse al pasado, presente o futuro; sabemos cuál a través de los marcadores de tiempo en la oración.

- Mi empresa me pidió que probara a trabajar una semana desde casa.

En oraciones compuestas que contienen el subjuntivo, la oración principal puede estar en:

el presente o presente perfecto de indicativo

Ejemplos:

- Es una lástima que no pueda trabajar desde casa.
- Me ha molestado que no tomaran nuestra opinión en cuenta.

un tiempo pasado: el imperfecto, el pretérito o el pasado perfecto

Ejemplos:

- Me encantaba que mi colega de oficina nos contara sus aventuras en el metro.
- Me molestó que mi colega de oficina pusiera la radio durante toda la mañana.
- Nuestro jefe nos había pedido que creáramos un buen ambiente para trabajar.
