| Yes/No       | Ja / Nee                  | yah / nay                         |

### Concept B: Formal versus informal greetings

| Fine, thank you.    | Goed, dank u.         | Goed, dank je.        |
| What's your name?   | Hoe heet u?           | Hoe heet je?          |
| Where are you from? | Waar komt u vandaan?  | Waar komt u vandaan?  |
| Where do you live?  | Waar woont u?         | Waar woon je?         |
| How old are you?    | Hoe oud bent u?       | Hoe oud ben je?       |
| Do you speak Dutch? | Spreekt u Nederlands? | Spreek je Nederlands? |
| Thank you.          | Dank u.               | Dank je.              |
