

Simple Future

الفعل المستقبل

Class objective : We are going to learn future simple tense and its usage along with how to make it .

Concept A- how to describe simple future in Arabic.

- As we learnt in the previous lesson, the present verb always begins with one of the following letters: (أ، إ، ي، ت، ن، ل)
- The future means that the action happens after the time of speaking. If one says: Muhammad will go to work سَيَذْهَبُ مُحَمَّدٌ إِلَى الْعَمَلِ, this means that he will go after some time (an hour, day, week, etc).
- Having understood the meaning of the future tense, we will learn how to formulate the verb in this tense.
- In the upcoming table, we will notice that there are two verbs: the first is يَذْهَبُ and its future form سَيَذْهَبُ. The future form of the verb is the same as the present tense with a pre-fixed letter seen (سَ) before the verb in the present tense:

س + الفعل الحاضر

sa- + the verb in the present form

| English | Transliteration | Arabic |

| They will do | Sayafalane | سَيَفْعَلَانِ |
