To revise all the concepts done so far.



Pronoun adverbs are the combination of a preposition and a pronoun. They are used only to refer to things (not for living things).

Beispiel: daran, darauf, hieraus, hierauf, woraus, wovon, usw...

Adverbs "da-" + preposition:

When objects following prepositions refer to <u>inanimate objects or things</u>, and we want to say 'with it', 'for it', 'to it', etc., we cannot simply replace the full noun with a pronoun. Instead, German replaces the noun with **da-**, which it attaches to the front of the preposition.



The adverbs "da-" + preposition are used very often and their translation depends on the context.

ADVERB	MEANING
dar an	at it
dar auf	On it
dar aus	From it
da bei	In the process , at the same time



da gegen	Against it
dar in	In it
da mit	With it
dar über	About it
da zu	additionally
da für	For it
dadurch	Thereby, in doing so



- > Ich fahre mit **dem Fahrrad** zur Arbeit.
 - Ich fahre **damit** zur Arbeit.
- > Ich verstehe nichts **von diesem Thema**.
 - Ich verstehe nichts <u>davon</u> (NOT 'von ihm').
- Note: When the preposition begins with a **vowel**, an **-r-** is added to aid pronunciation, thus making the compound dar + preposition.
- Wir freuen uns auf das Wochenende.
 - Wir freuen uns <u>darauf</u>
