Simple Future Tense

Class Objective:

I can use future tense appropriately in Bengali.

Concept A: First person-Singular (I - ami)

English	Bengali
I will do it.	Ami eta korbo.
I shall see you.	Ami tomay dekhbo .
Will I meet him?	Ami ki or sathe dekha korbo?
I will call you.	Ami tomake call korbo.

Concept B: First Person - Plural (We -amra)

English	Bengali
We will see to it.	Amra eta dekhe nebo.
We will need it.	Amader eta lagbe.
We will see you on Monday.	Amra tomake sombar dekhbo.
We will be busy tomorrow.	Amra kalke byasto thakbo.

Concept C: Second Person - Singular (You - apni/tumi)

English	Bengali
You will get it tomorrow,	Tumi eta kalke peye jabe.
You will need it.	Tomar eta lagbe.
Will you give me your book?	Tumi ki amake tomar boi debe?
You shall leave now.	Tomar ekhon jawa uchit.

Note:

- Tumi is used with younger ones or friends or close ones.
- Apni is used with elders (denotes respect)
