Concept A: Introduction

Right to constitutional remedies gives a citizen the right to approach a High Court or the Supreme Court to get any of the fundamental rights restored in case of their violation. The Supreme Court and the High Courts can issue orders and give directives to the government for the enforcement of rights.

Article 32 deals with the 'Right to Constitutional Remedies', or affirms the right to move the Supreme Court by appropriate proceedings for the enforcement of the rights conferred in Part III of the Constitution.

Concept B - Vocabulary

- Constitution- is a set of rules and regulations guiding the administration of a country. The constitution of India is the framework for political principles, procedures and powers of the government. The Constitution of India came into force on 26th January, 1950
- Writ- Writs are a written order from the Supreme Court or High Court that commands constitutional remedies for Indian Citizens against the violation of their fundamental rights.
- Fundamental right are a set of rights that are recognized under the laws of a country to protect their citizens.
- Enforcement-the act of compelling observance of or compliance with a law, rule, or obligation.
- Supreme Court- the highest judicial court in a country or state.

Concept C: Features

- 1. It ensures the protection of our fundamental rights.
- 2. It helps the citizens in moving court in case of violation of their fundamental rights.
- 3. It also sees that the government does not violate or disrespect the Fundamental Rights of the citizens.
- 4. This right protects and safeguards the citizen of all rights
