'Hometown' is called 'Grihnagar (गृहनगर) or Ganv(गाँव)' in Hindi.

'Neighbourhood' is known as 'Mohalla'(मोहल्ला) in Hindi.



Concept A: Talking about your neighbourhood

- I live in Dadar.
- Main Dadar main rehta hoon.
 - मैं दादर में रहता हूँ।
- There are many beaches here.
- Yahan bahut saare beech hain.
- यहाँ बहुत सारे बीच हैं।
- The Pani puri and chat of Dadar is very famous here.
- Yahan ke Golgappe aur chaat bahut prasiddh hain.
- यहाँ के गोलगप्पे और चाट बहुत प्रसिद्ध हैं।



Concept A: Talking about your neighbourhood

- My neighbourhood is very clean.
- Mera mohalla bahut saaf hai.
 - मेरा मोहल्ला बहुत साफ़ है।
- It is a peaceful neighbourhood.
- Yah ek shaantipoorn ilaaka hai.
- यह एक शांतिपूर्ण इलाका है।
- It is a lively neighbourhood.
- Yahan bahut chahal-pahal rehti hai.
- यहाँ बहुत चहल-पहल रहती है।



Concept B: Talking about Hometown

- Where do you live?
- Tum kahan rehte ho?
- तुम कहाँ रहते हो?
- What is the best food there?
- Wahan ka sabse acha khaana/ vyanjan kaunsa hai?
- वहाँ का सबसे अच्छा खाना/व्यंजन कौन सा है?
- My hometown is famous.
- Mera hometown / gao famous/prasidh hai.
- मेरा होमटाउन/गाँव फ़ेमस /प्रसिद्ध है।
