In Malayalam, the imperative form of a verb is not only used to issue commands but also regularly used to make requests.

This is done in Malayalam in two ways:

- a) an impolite and/or intimate/informal way and
- b) a polite or formal way.

Informal imperative form is used only to address young persons, servants, children and also used among close friends.

Sing a song.	Oru paattu paad. ഒരു പാട്ട് പാട്.
Eat this.	lthu kazhikk. ഇത് കഴിക്ക്.
Drink the juice.	Ee juice kudikk. ഈ ജ്യൂസ് കുടിക്ക്.
Don't open the door.	Door/Kathak thurakkenda. ഡോർ/കതക് ഇറക്കേണ്ട.
