

~(으)ㄴ/는 것 같다 / (으)ㄹ 것 같다 (to express a supposition based on intuitive/subjective reasons)

Class Objective:

I'll be able to express a statement that I'm not exactly sure of. I'm guessing that's the case.

The sentence pattern for using this grammar will be:

- Adjective / Past tense Verb + -ㄴ/은 것 같다
- Present tense Verb + -는 것 같다
- Future tense Verb + -ㄹ/을 것 같다

Concept A: When supposing the occurrence of an action or situation.

This expression is used when supposing

- that something happened in the past
- the occurrence of an action or situation that has yet to occur.

It corresponds to "looks/sounds like" or "appears that" in English.

1. For present tense adjectives and past tense verbs, ~(으)ㄴ is added to the stem.
2. For present tense verbs, ~는 is added.
3. For future tense verbs, ~(으)ㄹ is added.

Example 1:

- A. ~은/ㄴ 것 같다 is used with action verbs to make similar conjectures about the past.

그 남자는 맛있는 식당에서 삼겹살을 먹은 것 같아요. - That man probably ate samgyeopsal at the tasty restaurant.

어제 밤에 술을 많이 마신 것 같아. - It seems like you drank a lot of alcohol last night.

지난 주말에 명동에서 쇼핑한 것 같아요. - They probably went shopping in Myeongdong last weekend.

그 - that

남자 - man

맛있다 - to be delicious/tasty

맛있는 - delicious/tasty (noun modifier)

식당 - restaurant

어제 - yesterday

밤 - night

술 - alcohol

많이 - a lot

마시다 - to drink
