Noun is the name of a person, place or thing. It is called as 'Sangna' in Gujarati.

Examples of a few nouns:

English	Gujarati
book	Pustaka પુસ્તક
pen	Pen પેન
key	Chhavi <mark>યાવ</mark> ી
chair	Kurasi ખુરશી
child	Balak બાળક
flower	Phul ફૂલ
hand	Haath હાથ

Concept B: What is a pronoun?

Pronouns are words that are used instead of nouns. We call them 'Sarvanaam' in Gujarati.

Examples:

I - Hun / Mein &

You - Tame/ Te ਰਮੇ- ਰੇ

We - Ame અમે

Concept C: Set 1 - Pronouns

I - Hun/ Mein<mark>&</mark>

You - Tu/ Tame<mark>તમે- તે</mark>

He - Temane તે
