Concept A : Simple present Tense (First/second/Third person- Singular/ Plural)

English	Gujarati
I am a Doctor.	હું એક ડોક્ટર છું. Hu ek Doctor chhu
I go to the office.	હું ઓફિસ એ જાવ છું. Huoffice e jau chhu
You should drink the Milk	તમારે દૂધ પીવું જોઈએ. Tamare dudh pivu joie.
We are hungry.	અમે ભૂખ્યા છીએ. Ame Bhukhya chie.
She is not normal.	તેણી/ તે સામાન્ય નથી. Teni/ te samanay nathi.
It is my painting.	તે મારું પેઇન્ટિંગ છે. Te maru painting chhe.

Concept B : Present continuous Tense (First/second/Third person- Singular/ Plural)

English	Gujarati
I am going to the market.	હું બજાર જઈ રહ્યો છું./ રહી છું Hu bazaar jai rahyo chhu/ rahi chhu.
Birds are flying in the sky .	પક્ષીઓ આકાશમાં ઉડી રહ્યા છે pakshio aakash ma uddi rahya che
Are you going Canada?.	શું તમે કેનેડા જઈ રહ્યા છો?. Shu tame canada jai rahya chho?
He is working with me.	તે મારી સાથે કામ કરી રહ્યો છે. Te maari sathe kaam kari rahyo che
She is trying to call.	તે ફોન કરવાનો પ્રયાસ કરી રહી છે. Te phone karvano prayash kari rahi chhe.
They are Travelling.	તેઓ મુસાફરી કરી રહ્યા છે. Teo musafari kari rahya chhe.
