# Prepositions and Conjunctions in Hindi



## Concept A : Prepositions

**Definition :** Prepositions are the words or the group of words, which are generally placed before a noun or a pronoun to express its relation with other part of the sentence. The noun or pronoun used with the preposition is called its object. Prepositions are known as “Sambandhsoochak or poorvsarg” in Hindi.

पूर्वसर्ग वे शब्द या शब्दों के समूह हैं, जिन्हें आमतौर पर संज्ञा या सर्वनाम से पहले रखा जाता है। यह वाक्य के अन्य भाग के साथ अपने संबंध को व्यक्त करता है। जिस संज्ञा या सर्वनाम का प्रयोग पूर्वसर्ग के साथ किया जाता है, वह उसकी वस्तु कहलाती है। पूर्वसर्गों को हिंदी में "संबंधसूचक या पूर्वसर्ग" के रूप में जाना जाता है।



## Concept A : Prepositions

- poorvasarg ve shabd ya shabdon ke samuh hain, jinhen aam taur par
- sangya ya sarvanam se pahale rakha jaata hai. yah vakya ke any bhaag
- ke saath apne sambandh ko vyakt karta hai. jis sangya ya sarvanaam ka
- prayog poorvasarg ke saath kiya jaata hai, vah uski vastu kehlati hai.
- poorvasargon ko hindi mein "sambandhsoochak ya poorvasarg" ke
- roop mein jana jata hai.



## Concept B : Let us see a few sentence examples of Prepositions

### Example Sentences :

I am standing **at** counter no.1 .

Main counter number 1 par khada/khadi hoon.

मैं काउंटर नंबर 1 पर खड़ा/खड़ी हूँ।

The cat is sitting **on** the table.

Billi mez **par** baithi hai.

बिल्ली मेज़ पर बैठी है।

- She is **on** her way.
- Vah raste **mein** hai.
- वह रास्ते में है ।



## Concept C : Types of Prepositions in Hindi

### I. Preposition for time - kaal vachak sambandhbodhak : These

Prepositions are used to refer to the time.

Eg: at, on, in

#### 1. He will come **on** Monday.

Vah Somvaar **ko** aayega.

वह सोमवार को आएगा ।

#### 2. The stars twinkle **at** night.

Sitare raat **mein** timtimate hain.

सितारे रात में टिमटिमाते हैं ।
