

V-는데 걸리다/들다

Class Objective:

I'll be able to learn the grammar: V-는데 걸리다/들다.

Introduction:

This expression is added to the end of verbs to express how much money, time, or effort is involved in doing a task.

This expression corresponds to 'takes/ requires/costs ... to (do)' in English.

Sentence pattern for using this grammar will be:

- Adding **는데 걸리다/들다** to the verb stems.
- **~는 데 걸리다** is used when expressing an amount of time required
- **~는 데 들다** is used when expressing an amount of money required

Concept A: V-는 데 걸리다 (is used for time)

- V-는 데 걸리다 is used when expressing an amount of time required.

- When describing “데” this way, the speaker can indicate that it takes a certain amount of time (or resources) to complete an action.

- The action that is being done is placed before ~는 데, and the time (or resources) it requires is placed after ~는 데.

Conjugation :

가다 + -는데 →가는데

읽다 → 읽는데

*만들다 → 만드는데

밥을 다 먹는 데 = how long it took to “eat all of the food” (밥을 다 먹는다)

밥을 다 먹는 데 한 시간 걸렸어요 - It took an hour to eat all the food.

여기까지 오는 데 시간이 많이 걸렸어요 - It took a long time for me to come here.

문을 여는 데 시간이 왜 이렇게 오래 걸려요? - Why is it taking so long to open the door?

Concept B: V-는 데 들다 (is used for money)

- V-는 데 들다 is mostly used when expressing an amount of money required.

- When describing “데” this way, the speaker can indicate that it takes a certain amount of time (or resources) to complete an action.
