Concept A: Understanding:

Amazing meaning: inspiring fear, or tinges of fear mixed with admiration

Below are many words that can be used interchangeably, and all of them mean something close to creating a feeling of greatness. If you want to describe something very good, try to use these words.

1 Fantastic: extraordinarily good

Examples

- The Broadway show that we saw last night was fantastic!
- Amanda, you did a fantastic job on this report!

2 Great: of a considerable amount above the average

Examples

- The team played a great game, but they still lost in the end.
- In order to be a great leader, you have to understand the goals that you are trying to achieve and the strengths of your team members.

3 Astonishing: surprising to the point of being impressive

Examples

- The number of hot dogs that the hot dog eating contest champion ate was astonishing!
- It is absolutely astonishing how many people think that climate change is not a man made phenomenon.
- Now that really is astonishing.
- Astonishing! She stood now too.
- They have an astonishing 438,000.
- He hit upon astonishing inventions.
