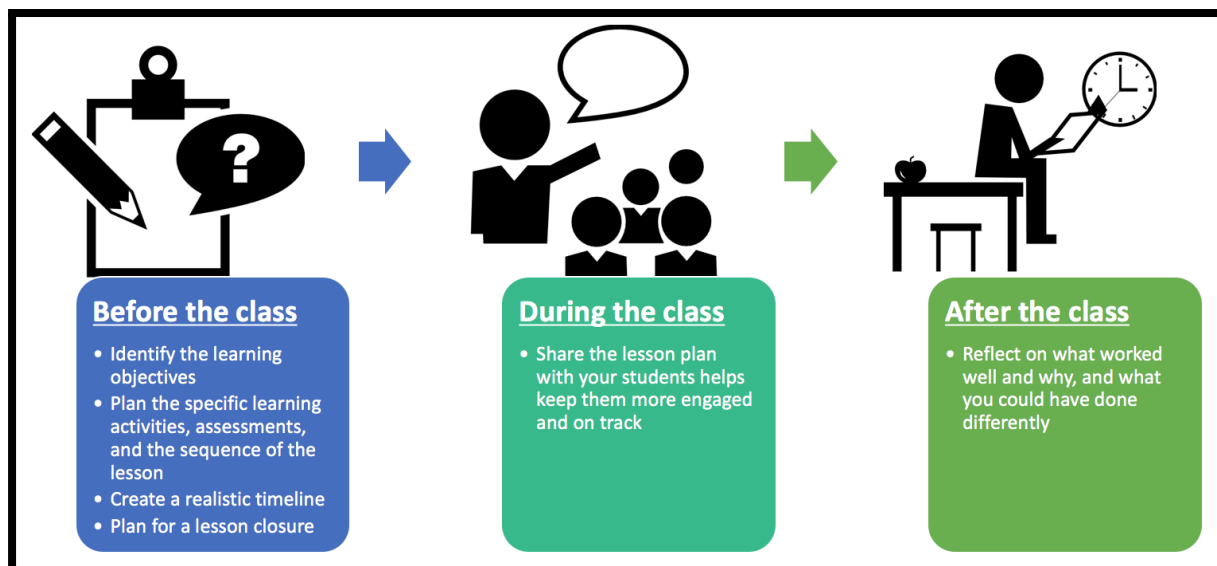


How you plan to prepare for class, as a teacher and as a student.
