

Adverbs and prepositions of place

Concept A: Adverb of place

Definition:

- Un adverbe est un mot qui modifie un verbe, un adjectif ou un autre adverbe. Il exprime souvent comment le sujet effectue une action.

An adverb is a word that modifies a verb, an adjective, or another adverb. It often expresses how the subject performs an action.

Exemples -

- À droite : on the right
- À gauche : on the left
- À l'intérieur : inside; indoors
- À l'extérieur : outside; outdoors
- Ailleurs : elsewhere
- Au-dessous : below
- Au-dessus : above
- Au fond : at the bottom
- (tout) autour : (all) around
- D'ailleurs : besides
- Dedans : inside; indoors
- Dehors : outside; outdoors
- Derrière : behind
- Dessous : below
- Dessus : above
- Devant : in front
- En bas : down; downstairs
- En haut : up; upstairs
- Ici : here (also: up here; down here)
- Là : there
- Là-bas : over there; down there
- Là-haut : up there
- Loin : far away
- N'importe où : anywhere
- Nulle part : nowhere
