Concept B: Find the correct adjective ending.

- There are two kinds of adjective endings, the **strong ending** and the **weak**
- ending, which roughly correspond to the two tables above. Whenever you
 - use a strong ending or a weak ending depends on which article (der, ein) is

used.

• After an indefinite article, use the strong ending.

• After a definite article, use the weak ending.

Strong ending rules

In any of the following three cases, the adjectives take what is called the

Strong ending

- Indefinite articles
- Possessives
- Kein/keinen/keine
