Dative and prepositional cases in Russian Grammar.

Class objective: Get familiar with the dative and prepositional cases of nouns in Russian grammar.

Concept A: Applications and declension of nouns in dative case.

Applications of the Dative Case.

1. To show the receiver of the action, most often an indirect object in the sentence.

Я даю журнал <u>студенту</u>. – I'm giving the magazine <u>to the student</u>.

The word *cmyденту* (to the student) is the dative case form of the word *cmyдент* (student) and indicates the receiver of the action (give).

Usually, the dative case is used after the verbs which mean addressing someone, giving something, speaking and communicating:

говорить – to tell

давать – to give

разрешать - to allow

помогать – to help

звонить – to call, to phone

приносить – to bring

Мать подарила *мне* мотоцикл.

Mother gifted *me* a motorcycle.

Here **me** is in dative case.

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
