

Estar a + infinitivo

Class objective : I will be able to use the verb estar in Portuguese.

Concept A: Recall the use of “Estar”

Verb ESTAR in Portuguese is used to indicate:

1) Non-permanent states

Exemplos:

1. Hoje está calor.
Today is hot.
2. hoje está frio.
Today is cold.
3. Hoje está chuvoso.
Today is rainy.

2) Transient location

Exemplos:

1. Eles estão na praia.
They are at the beach.
2. Eles estão ao restaurante.
They are at restro.
3. Ele está na casa.
She's at home.

3) Position

Exemplos:

1. Natália está sentada.
Natália is seated.
2. Ela está em pé.
She's standing.
3. Ela está caminhando.
She's walking.

4) Clothing

Exemplos:

1. Nós estamos de paletó e gravata.
We are using a suit and a tie.
2. Estou a vester-se como o Deu.
I am dressing up like a dog.
3. Estou a fazer o trabalho.
I'm doing work.
4. Estou a trabalhar.
I'm working.
