Advanced Intensifiers

Class Objective: I will be able to understand the concept of Intensifiers.

Concept A: What are Intensifiers?

A Word that weakens or strengthens another word is known as intensifier.

Example: I am very angry.

Here the word very is intensifier that strengthens the meaning.

• Example: I am **fairly** angry

Here the word fairly is intensifier that weakens the meaning.

Concept B: Some sentences with intensifiers.

- She was **so** upset. I felt **extremely** sorry for her.
- She has a **very** strict teacher.
- Don't work **too** hard. Sometimes you'll get more done by relaxing a bit.
- I don't think she understood the topic and her essay was rather a mess.
- She's really offended her sister .:
- I strongly disagree.
- It's extremely hot in Africa.
- That is a phenomenally tall building.
