Concept A: Grammar

1. V1 てForm / V1 ない Form ないで V2

V1 is an action or condition which accompanies the action denoted by V2. Look at the examples. Using this pattern, whether soy sauce is used or not when the action たべます takes place is stated. V1 and V2 are actions done by the same person.

1) しょうゆを つけて 食(た)べます。

We eat it with soy sauce.

2) しょうゆを つけないで 食(た)べます。

We eat it without soy sauce.

2. **V1** ない Form ないで**V2**

This pattern is used when the speaker indicates a course of action taken out of two alternative possibilities presented.

1) 日曜日(にちようび)は どこも いかないで、うちで ゆっくり 休(やす)みます。
Next Sunday I won't go anywhere. I will rest at home instead.
