This sentence pattern indicates that the action described by the verb does not have to be done.

④ あした 来なくても いいです。 You don't have to come tomorrow.

You learned in Lesson 6 that the particle \mathcal{E} is attached to the direct object of verbs. Here you learn that the object is made a topic by replacing \mathcal{E} with \mathcal{I} .

ここに 荷物を 置かないで ください。

Please don't put parcels here.

- ⑤ 荷物<u>は</u> ここに 置かないで ください。 As for parcels, don't put them here. 会社の 食堂で 昼ごはん<u>を</u> 食べます。 I have lunch in the company cafeteria.
- ⑥ 昼ごはん<u>は</u> 会社の 食堂で 食べます。 As for lunch, I have it in the company cafeteria.

N(time)までに V

The point in time indicated by $\sharp \mathcal{T} = \emptyset$ is the time limit by which an action is to be done.

- ⑦ 会議は 5時までに 終わります。 The meeting will be over by five.
- ⑧ 土曜日までに 本を 返さなければ なりません。

I must return the book by Saturday.

[Note] Make sure you do not confuse \$\mathcal{z} \cdots \text{ with the particle \$\mathcal{z}\$ c.

I work until five. (L. 4)
