### Concept A

#### Tongue twister and pronunciation of R sound

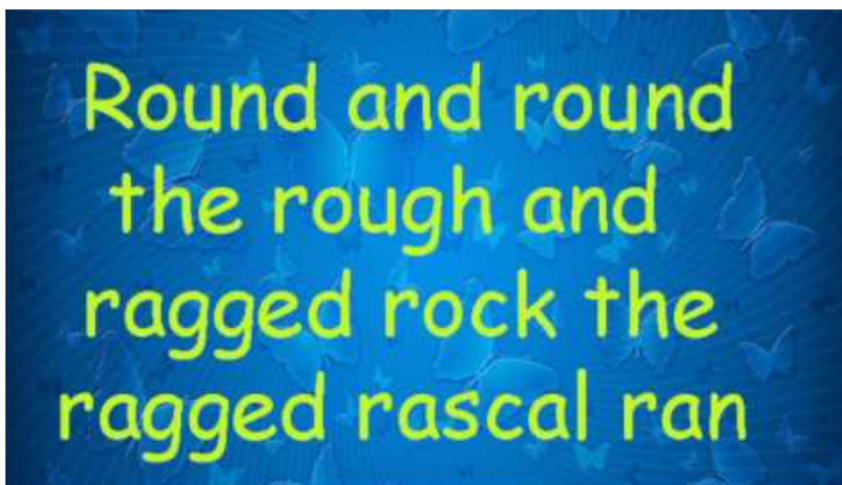
Tongue twisters are short sentences created by the repeated pronunciation of a specific letter.

**To pronounce the R alphabet-** To correctly make the R sound, your tongue needs to be in the correct position. Raise the back of your tongue to lightly touch the back teeth on both sides of your mouth. The center part of the back of your tongue should be lower to allow air to move over it. The tip of your tongue may curve a little, but it will not touch your mouth or lips. Your tongue will be tense. It will not be loose.
