

La'alla and it's usage

Class Objective:

To learn La'alla and it's usage.

Synopsis:

- We remind you that the nominal sentence consists of two main parts:
The subject (المُبْتَدَأُ /al mubtada)
The predicate (الخبر /al khabar/)
The subject and the predicate are both originally in nominative case, i.e. is signed originally with /ḍammah/ (ء) on the last letter.
- The annullers which we will study in this lesson are not verbs, instead they are particles. These annullers are called in Arabic (الحُرُوفُ النَّاسِخَةُ /al ḥurūf an nāsikhah/), i.e. the annuler particles.
- We will only study one of the annuler particles in this lesson - /La'alla/ and its uses. In this lesson we will learn what /La'alla/ means and what its uses are. Please have a look at the following examples (read from right to left):
- We will also learn in this lesson the function of /La'alla/ and its uses. We will study their effect on the declension of the two parts of the nominal sentence, i.e. the subject and the predicate. Look at the following examples, and consider the declension before and after the annuler particle:

Concept A: La'alla

La'alla/ لعل also means wish or hope, but, unlike /layta/, it is used for a wish that you think is expected to happen, as in the following examples:

Here's the conjugation of La'allal/لعل with nouns.

English	Transliteration	Arabic
I hope that the students succeed.	La'allat tullabu yanjahun.	لعل الطلاب ينجحون
I hope that the father comes back soon.	La'allal abu yarjau besurah.	لعل الأب يرجع بسرعة
I hope that the teacher doesn't teach today.	La'allal ustazu la yudarresul yom.	لعل الأستاذ لا يدرس اليوم
I hope that the beggar says something.	La'allas sayelu yaqulu shai'an.	لعل السائل يقول شيئا
I hope that the mother cooks the food.	La'allal ummu tatbukhat ta'am.	لعل الام تطبخ الطعام
I hope that my son studies.	La'allal ibnu yadrusu.	لعل الابن يدرس
