

Future Continuous Tense in Hindi

Class Objective : Learning Future continuous Tense in Hindi

Concept A : Future continuous tense

Definition : The Future continuous tense denotes that an action will occur in the future and will continue for an expected length of time. Future continuous tense is known as Apurna Bhavishya kaal / अपूर्ण भविष्य काल in Hindi.

Concept B : Future continuous tense

I. Future Continuous tense- Apurna bhavishya kaal / अपूर्ण भविष्य काल

This tense is also called future progressive tense. If we use the words such as "raha hoga/ rahe honge/ rahi hogi/ rahenge" / रहा होगा / रहे होंगे / रही होगी / रहेंगे"

at the end of the sentence then that sentence is known as future continuous.

1. He will be singing a song.

Vah gana gaa raha hoga./ वह गाना गा रहा होगा

2. she will be eating food.

Vah khana kha rahi hogi/ वह खाना खा रही होगी.

Concept D: Use of future continuous tense

1. We use the future continuous tense to indicate actions that will continue to happen in the future.

Eg: He will be completing his homework.

Vah uska homework pura kar raha hoga/ वह उसका होमवर्क पूरा कर रहा होगा.

Sita will be going for a walk.

Sita ghumne jaa rahi hogi./ सीता घूमने जा रही होगी.
