IMPERATIVE FORMS OF VERBS

CLASS OBJECTIVE: To learn the use of imperative forms of verbs.

CONCEPT A: Learn to form imperatives from verbs.

- · Imperative forms of verbs are used to express command, order and duty.
- · Imperatives are always used to address second person subjects.
- · Imperative forms of verbs are made by substituting the suffix part of verb conjugation and by adding "й" and "йте" suffixes.
- While the suffix "MTE" is used in the formal sense and to address plural subjects.

Let's learn how to form imperatives. For example, we shall be discussing the conjugation of "**ЧИТАТЬ**".

	Singular	Plural
1 st person	чита́ю	чита́ем
2 nd person	чита́ешь	чита́ете
3 rd person	чита́ет	чита́ют

Here, we will have to keep the stem intact i.e. "чита́" and then we'll have to add the suffixes "й" and "йте".
