A question without an interrogative is used as a component of a sentence in this sentence pattern.
Note that どうか is necessary after "plain form か"

1. 忘年会(ぼうねんかい)に 出席(しゅっせき)するか どうか、20(はつ)日(か)までに 返事(へんじ)を ください。

Please answer by the 20th whether you'll attend the year-end party or not.

2. その話(はなし)は ほんとうか どうか、わかりません。

I don't know whether the story is true or not.

3. まちがいがないか どうか、調(しら)べて ください。

Please check if there are no mistakes.

In 3, not まちがいがあるか どうか but まちがいがないか どうか is used because the speaker wants to confirm that there are no mistakes.

・いーAdj(～い)→ ～さ

Change the final い of a いーAdj into さ, and you can transform the adjective into a noun.

1. 山(やま)の 高(たか)さは どうやって 測(はか)るか、知(し)っていますか。

Do you know how to measure the height of a mountain?

2. 新(あたらしい) 橋(はし)の 長(なが)さは 3,911メートルです。

The new bridge is 3,911 meters long.
