

Class Objective: Essay on the topic "lying"

Concept A: Was ist Lügen?

Lügen ist eine komplizierte Dimension der eigenen Persönlichkeit, eine menschliche Natur, die durch ein gewohnheitsmäßiges Verhalten gekennzeichnet ist. Viele Leute würden sagen, dass Lügen moralisch falsch ist, weil es die Würde und Integrität einer Person zerstört. Lügen repräsentiert die Angst vor dem, was andere denken könnten, und die Angst, sich der Realität zu stellen, die mit jeder Lüge, die eine Person erzählt, stärker wird.

Während eine Lüge zur nächsten führt, betrügen sich die Menschen selbst, indem sie Ausreden für ihre Lügen finden. Während die Gesellschaft Lügen als ethisches Vergehen betrachtet hat, gibt es Fälle, in denen instinktives Lügen die einzig perfekte Option ist. Warum lügen Menschen? Leute lügen aus einer Reihe von Gründen, wie z. B. um Streitigkeiten zu vermeiden, sich vor Schaden, Zurückweisung oder Verlust zu schützen sowie die Privatsphäre und Glaubwürdigkeit zu schützen. Manche Menschen lügen aus eigenem Interesse und manche können aus einem gerechtfertigten Grund oder Grund lügen oder wenn man nicht in der Lage ist, mit den Folgen der Wahrheitserklärung umzugehen.

Concept B: Wie Menschen lügen

Menschen verwenden verschiedene Arten des Lügens, die normalerweise bereits in der Kindheit beginnen. Kinder belügen ihre Eltern, um einer Bestrafung zu entgehen, aus Schwierigkeiten herauszukommen oder Aufmerksamkeit zu erregen, und manchmal ohne ersichtlichen Grund.
