Concept B: tips for email writing

- Every letter or email starts with a salutation - e.g. "Hallo Max," and ends with a greeting - e.g. "Liebe Grüße". In German we distinguish between polite (formal) and personal letters. For this there are always suitable salutations and greetings. Below the greeting is the name - in a formal letter the full name and in a personal letter only the first name.
