Class Objective:

Concept A: What is a picture comprehension?

- A picture comprehension is an activity where one looks at pictures, finds interesting details and then answers simple questions about the picture.
- These questions are usually based around whom, what, where, when and why.
- Some questions you might find in a picture comprehension are things like "what is the name of the park in the photo?" or "how many people with ice creams can you see?"

Concept B: Importance of a picture comprehension?

- Using a picture comprehension can help get children ready for reading comprehensions.
- One can use simple sentences to describe what is present or happening in the photo and start to understand how to take their reading further.
- Picture comprehensions give the opportunity to practice describing what is in an image and to choose a sentence that best matches the picture.
- It's a great starting point for decoding and understanding stories.
