Some examples :

Die Fluss fließt durch die Stadt.

The river flows through the city.

Was hast du **gegen** mich?

What do you have against me?

Ich habe schon **für** die Prüfung vorbereitet.

I have already prepared for the examination.



#### The Accusative Prepositions (Akkusativ Präpositionen):

Durch - through

Wir laufen durch **die** ganze Stadt. We are walking through the entire city.

- Um at/ around
  - a. At for exact timeEr kommt um 17:00 Uhr.He is coming at 5:00 p.m.



B. Around

Wir machen einen Spaziergang um den See.

We're going for a walk around the lake.

In der Besprechung sitzen wir um den Konferenztisch.

In the meeting we sit around the conference table.

Gegen - against

Er ist gegen Atomkraft.

He is against nuclear power.
