Basic Sentence formation

Class Objective:

I am able to form simple sentences in Bengali.

Concept A: Introduction to basic sentence formation

In Bengali most of the sentences end with the verb.

Examples:

I hit him. Aami oke **merechhi**. আমি ওকে মেরেছি।

I bought milk. Aami dudh **kinechhilaam**. আমি দৃধ কিলেছিলাম।

Note: Generally Bengali sentences have a Subject Object Verb (SOV) pattern. It can be SVO or OSV sometimes.

Examples:

The bus arrived at the bus stop. Bus-ta bus stop-e eseche.(SOV) বাসটা বাস স্টপে এসেছে।

Bus stop-e bus-ta eseche.(OSV) বাস স্টপে বাসটা এসেছে।

English	Bengali
He is a teacher.	Uni ekjon sikkhok. উনি একজন শিক্ষক
He came.	Uni esechhen. উনি এসেছেন।
This is mine.	Etaa aamar. এটা আমার।
She ate.	Uni kheyechhen. উনি খেয়েছেন।
He came fast.	Uni taaraatari esechhen. উনি তাড়াতাড়ি এসেছেন।
