Allude	to make a secretive Synonym- suggest	She alluded to the problem at hand but didn't say anything more about it.
Altercation	Synonym- confrontation	Greg got into an altercation with a stranger at the bar.
Ambiguous	Synonym- unclear or vague	Her ambiguous statement made me question whether she could be trusted.
Ambitious	having a powerful desire for success or Synonym -achievement	Penny is so ambitious , she wants to be president someday.
Ambivalence	the state of being uncertain or stuck between two or more options Synonym- uncertain	His ambivalence prevented him from immediately signing the contract.
Analogous	Synonym- similar but not identical	Green onions are considered analogous to spring onions.
