## Concept A. What is Passive Voice?

- Passive voice is used to highlight the subject which undergoes the action as opposed to the active voice where the main highlight is on the subject
  - Beispiel- Active voice: **Er hat** mich informiert.- **He** informed me.

which performs the action.

- Passive voice: *Ich werde* informiert.- I was informed.
- In the first sentence, the focus was on the subject who performed the action, i.e. 'He'. But in the second sentence, the interest was more on the subject, on which the action was performed, i.e. 'I'.



### Concept A. What is Passive Voice?

- While constructing a sentence of passive voice in German, often the verb
- 'werden' is used in its conjugated form(depending on the subject) in the
- second position, and the verb which conveys the action is in its past
- participle/partizip II form, placed at the end.

#### Concept B. Formen: Forms of Passiv

While forming a passive voice for a sentence with an accusative form of

subject, in the passive form, the subject changes to Nominative.

Beispiel- Er hat **mich** informiert.- Aktivsatz
