Particle ^

- Note -

In general \sim is pronounced "he", but when it is a particle, it is pronounced "e".

- へいわ ・平和 heiwa (noun): peace
- やまい・山へ 行く yama e iku (particle): I will go to the mountain

This particle may be translated as the preposition "to" in English.



2) Destination: Like the particle , the particle an also indicate the destination.

来 年ケンはイギリスへ行きます。
 Ken will go to the UK next year.





Particle &

- 1) The particle *\(\frac{1}{2} \) indicates the direct object of a transitive verb.
- 昨日 日本の映画を見ました。
 Yesterday I saw a Japanese movie.

● 毎朝コーヒーを飲みます。
I drink coffee every morning.





The Particle [may be translated as the preposition "to / at" in English.

- 3) Specific time: The particle | indicates a time.
- かんじ でんしゃ 何時に電車は来ますか。
 What time will the train come?
