

Subject verb agreement

Class Objective:

I will be able to form complex sentences in Telugu.

Concept A: Introduction to complex sentence formation

Most of the sentences end with the verb in Telugu.

I am going to a park and will go to my friend's house.

Nenu oka park ki **veltunnanu** mariyu na snehitudu intiki **veltaanu**.

I am working in an office.

Nenu office / kaaryaalayam lo **panichestunnanu**.

I am eating maggie and will go to a movie.

Nenu maggie **tintunaanu** mariyu cinema ki **veltanu**.

Note: Telugu is a word free order language. Generally, the sentences in Telugu have a Subject Object Verb (SOV) pattern. It can also be OSV sometimes.

Example:

I am going to the movie.

Nenu cinema ki velthunnaan.(SOV)

Cinema ki nenu velthunnaan(OSV)

English	Telugu
The teacher wrote the question on the blackboard.	Guruvu/ Teacher nallaballa/ blackboard pai prasna/ question rasaru.
In order to succeed in a career in business, Riya studied economics.	Business careerlo vijayam/ success sadinchadanik Riya economics chadivindi.
They studied GK.	Vaaru GK aadhyayanam chesaru.
There are many reasons why I can't help you.	Nenu meeku sahaayam cheyalekapovadaniki chaala kaaranaalu unnayi.
Walking long distances improves blood circulation.	Ekkuva dooram nadavadam valla rakha prasarana/ circulation merugupadutundi.
