Examples:

- In
- On
- Of
- From

Example sentences

He prefers to read in the library.

He climbed **up** the ladder.

They swam across the river.

Take your brother with you.

Please don't go down the stairs.

He wakes **up** before sunrise.

I was born at exactly 2 am.

He works at night too.

During the holidays, I learnt to ski.

The store is open **till** midnight.
