

NEGATION IN RUSSIAN LANGUAGE

CLASS OBJECTIVE: Learn the aspects of negation in Russian Grammar.

CONCEPT A: Simple negation.

In order to form negative sentences or phrases in Russian, one shall always use the preposition “**не**” just before the verbs, which conveys the meaning of **don’t** or **doesn’t** in present tense, **didn’t** in past and **will not** in future tense.

- Я пойду в зоопарк.
- I will go to the zoo.
- Я съел яблоко.
- I ate an apple.
- Она училась.
- She was studying.
- Он играет на флейте.
- He plays the flute.
- Они играют в футбол.
- They play football.

NEGATIVE PHRASES/ SENTENCES.

- Я НЕ пойду в зоопарк.
- I will NOT go to the zoo.
- Я НЕ ел яблоко.
- I DIDN'T eat apple.
