

Expressing possibility with Indicative/Subjunctive

Objetivo de clase : Entender cómo se expresa la probabilidad en español usando el indicativo y el subjuntivo.

Concepto A : Cómo se expresar probabilidad en español

¿Cómo se expresa la probabilidad en español? Bueno, puedes usar varias expresiones y algunos tiempos verbales diferentes. En la mayoría de los casos usamos el modo subjuntivo posteriormente, pero hay casos en los que también se puede usar el modo indicativo.

Probablemente te hayas preguntado muchas veces cómo expresar probabilidad cuando hablas de cosas que han sucedido, cosas que están sucediendo o cosas que van a suceder. Para todos estos casos veremos ejemplos en nuestra explicación.

Para empezar, creemos un contexto:

¿Sabes dónde está Lucas? Estoy llamando a su despacho y no contesta.

Cómo expresar probabilidad en español usando diferentes tiempos verbales :

1. FUTURO SIMPLE - Hipótesis en el presente.

Estará comiendo, es su hora de descanso.

2. FUTURO COMPUESTO - Hipótesis sobre una acción terminada con consecuencias en el presente.

Habrá ido al despacho del director.

3. SIMPLE CONDICIONAL - Hipótesis sobre el pasado.

En este caso no podemos usarlo con la situación inicial porque siempre se usa para hipótesis sobre una situación pasada.

- ¿Sabes qué le pasó ayer a Lucas? Estaba muy raro.
- Pues no lo sé, supongo que le dolería la cabeza.
