

NOUNS AND GENDERS

CLASS OBJECTIVE: To learn the types of nouns, their plurals and genders in Russian Language.

CONCEPT A: Types of nouns

Одушевленные существительные/Living Nouns: This type includes the names of all living beings like Humans, animals and plants.

e.g: Человек, Тигр, и.т.д.

Неодушевленные существительные/ Non-living Nouns: This type includes the names of all non living entities.

E.g: машина, мотоцикл и.т.д.

Нарицательные существительные/ Common Nouns: Name of all subjects, states and actions. E.g: кровать, машина, дом.

Собственные существительные/Proper nouns: Personal Names of all persons, place and other entities, which differentiates them from their group. E.g: Ваня, Света, Марья Ивановна, Париж, Нью-Йорк, Сингапур, Тихий океан.

Абстрактные существительные /Abstract nouns: Names denoting an idea, feelings, quality, or state rather than a concrete object. E.g: забота, дружба, любовь.

Собирательные существительные/ Collective Nouns : This type includes the names of a group belonging to a certain idea. E.g: студенчество, мебель.

CONCEPT B: 3 Genders of nouns and their respective endings .

Мужской Род/Masculine Gender: Nouns having an ending of consonant, except **-а**, **-я**, **-о**. These words may have an ending of soft sign as well **-ь**, **й**

E.g: кот, стол, брат, дом, ствол, нож.

Женский Род/Feminine Gender: Nouns having an of **-а**, **-я**, and **-ь**, should be determined as a word of feminine gender.

E.g: кошка, чашка, мать, змея, Родина, терраса.

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
