# **Concept A: Introduction**

**Show and tell** is an activity where an object is taken and shown to the audience. The speaker will describe the object in detail. Eg- It could be a toy or a hobby, or any favorite item. It helps in developing storytelling ability, building connections and bonds between students. It helps teachers to gauge their students, and enhance student's communication skills.

## **Possible Topics**

- A favorite item of their choice
- Something from a holiday, old or recent.
- An excerpt on postcard, a souvenir or a holiday journal
- A family recipe. ...
- About a family member ...
- A photo of a pet
- A photo of a best friend. ...
- My favorite outfit.
- An art or craft work created-pottery, calligraphy etc
- Any collectible figures.
- photos of great memories.
- a special succulent
- a favorite book.
- Photos of your baking skills
- Any DIY recycled art work

### Concept B: Steps to be followed

- 1. Introduce yourself
- 2. Maintain a short smile
- 3. Be confident
- 4. While speaking pay attention to details like grammar, pronunciation, and sentence formation.
- 5. Always look around at your audience as much as possible.
- 6. Speak in a loud and clear voice.
- 7. Stand still or walk comfortably with the object and describe.
- 8. While describing, use words or adjectives to describe your adventure or object.
- 9. Be brief and to the point.
